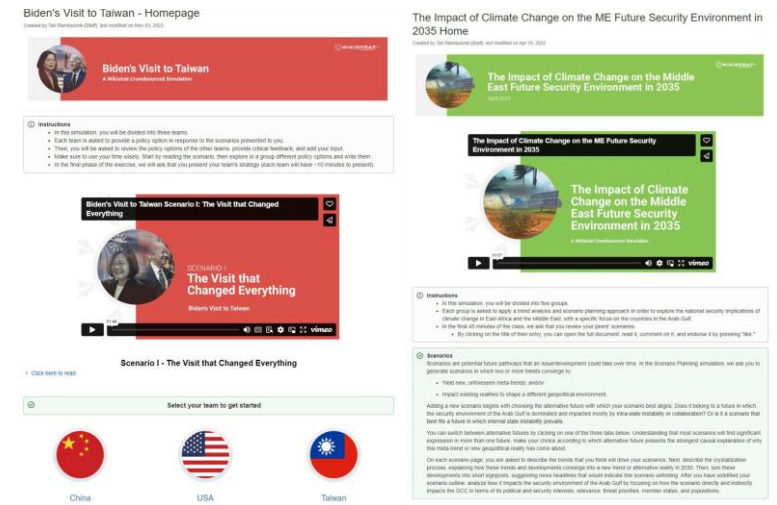
Our Workshops

For the past two years, Wikistrat has been running exclusive workshops for organizations, companies, and government agencies across the world.

The workshops involve a mix of simulations, professional lectures, and training courses using our network of experts and online platform.

Case Study

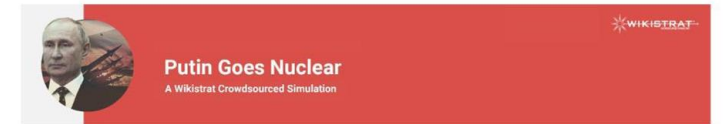
In 2023, Wikistrat held a series of 12 workshops for a governmental body that operated within the framework of foreign affairs and security.

These included seminars with leading experts from the fields of diplomacy and security, intelligence officers and world-renowned lecturers.

These were followed by interactive online simulations on topics such as:

- Biden’s Visit to Taiwan
- Putin Goes Nuclear
- A Chinese Carrier Enters the Arab Gulf
- The Impact of Climate Change on the ME Future Security Environment in 2035
- The Next Iranian Military Intervention

Each workshop included 30-50 participants, ran over 3-4 consecutive days and included lectures by 4-5 different experts and 2-3 simulations.



Instructions

- In this simulation, you will be divided into three teams.
- Each team is asked to provide a policy option in response to the scenarios presented to you.
- Then, you will be asked to review the policy options of the other teams, provide critical feedback, and add your input.
- Make sure to use your time wisely. Start by reading the scenario, then explore in a group different policy options and write them.
- In the final phase of the exercise, we will ask that you present your team's strategy (each team will have ~10 minutes to present).
